<p>Band</p> <p>Studies have shown that music activities in school enhance student capacity to learn, and improves academic performance in all subjects. Being part of a Junior High Band helps build skills in socialization, encourages self-expression, and lowers stress levels. This course is a hands-on approach to learning to play an instrument of the student's choice. Students will become proficient at their instrument, and will have opportunities to play at school functions. Students will choose between flute, clarinet, trumpet and trombone. Each student will be responsible for renting or purchasing their own instrument. No previous musical experience is required.</p>	<p>Mrs. Matychuk</p>
<p>Art</p> <p>The Visual Arts course will "support, nurture and inspire the growth of every student as an artist and artful learner". Students will be provided with many opportunities to explore various techniques, mediums and forms of expression through engaging student-centred activities. Students will utilize artistic media to communicate, and will participate in projects that will increase visual literacy, teach them to engage with the visual world, and learn how to view artistic works sensitively and critically. Throughout the year students will create original art using acrylics, pencil, charcoal, collage techniques, printmaking supplies and much more. To celebrate the growth and development of the artists in the class, they will participate in a year end gallery and have the opportunity to showcase the works they are most proud of.</p>	<p>Mrs. Kjell</p>
<p>Digital Graphics Level 1</p> <p>An introduction to the fundamentals of graphic design. Topics include: vector and raster graphics, desktop publishing and digital photography. Projects include creating vector illustrations, vinyl decals, and screen printing.</p>	<p>Mr. Zonneveld</p>

<p>Digital Graphics Level 2 This course builds on the knowledge and skills from Graphics I. Projects include complex vector illustrations, glass etching, and student-initiated contract projects (i.e. posters, stickers, and shirts) for the St. Ignatius Community.</p>

<p>Dramatic Arts Taking drama classes in Junior High has been shown to improve skills in communication, teamwork, leadership, listening and responding, and creativity. Through drama students gain self-control, build new friendships, and build skills in communication. The objectives of this course is to build an appreciation for, and an understanding of theatre and its mechanics.
